This summer our staff has enjoyed walking through different chapters in the Psalms as we preached the Summer in the Psalms series. We hope that this experience in Psalms has been as much of a blessing to you. As we end summer and kick off into the school year we CELEBRATE together and start a new sermon series entitled "Different Church".

During 2024 we have been using the word Different a lot understanding that as God's people we are transformed by the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. We are made different when we follow Christ.

In "Different Church" we are going to look at "The Church" which is the bride of Christ. The bride of Christ is set apart for Him. The Church was Different from its inception, from the moment Jesus gave the command to go make disciples and the Holy Spirit fell upon the Disciples at Pentecost. The book of Acts and the writings in the New Testament show us the acts of the Disciples and how the Church was given a mission and purpose to be different than the world. We will explore what that means for us at Trinity Church. During this series we will consider what that means for us individually and collectively. We will explore what it means to be multigenerational, intentional with connection, prayerfully Godconfident, unoffendable, grace-filled, and unity focused, not rivalry focused.

The struggle is we live in a broken and fallen world; it's easy to live and learn from the world and interact and live like the world. Yet we are the church, the body of Christ, and we are meant to be different. Interact different, Love different, respond different, think different, and be different for the sake of the Cospel for the world.

I look forward to exploring how we at Trinity are called to be a Different Church.

FROM THE CALL TEAM FOR LEAD PASTOR

The Lead Pastor Call Team has continued to meet regularly in July. At our July 9th meeting we received a call process orientation from the Assistant to the Nebraska Synod Bishop, Pastor Greg Berger. As the Synod's call process designee, Pastor Greg is our "head hunter" for contacting and interacting with potential pastor candidates.

Our team has completed the preparation phase of the call process and is ready start to the next phase of contacting and interviewing candidates. Part of our preparation was to assist the Church Council to draft a Ministry Site Profile (MSP) which gives potential candidates a description of our church and its ministries. Once the MSP has been received by the Synod, Pastor Greg will start sharing names and profiles of interested candidates. Our team is also looking to add a video to the MSP which will show off our congregation and community in ways the MSP is not designed to.

The Call Team is setting up a series of forums where members of the congregation can express to the Call Team what they are looking for in a Lead Pastor. The first forums were held on July 22nd for church staff and council. Forums for the entire congregation will take place in the Chapel on August 25 and September 8 at 11:30 a.m. and during or after the Legacy Group on September 5th. Please choose to attend ONE. We will also have questionnaires for those unable to attend the forums.

The Call Team also welcomes your suggestions for possible candidates to call to be our next pastor. A form is available for the congregation to submit nominations which will be forwarded to the Nebraska Synod. (Use the QR Code or link below) The synod will contact nominees in Nebraska and will contact the bishops of nominees in other synods. Receipt of this nomination form, however, does not guarantee an interview by our call team.





FROM THE MISSIONS TEAM



THE RAINING SEASON continues to be a Trinity Church Global Mission Partner. TRS is an orphanage in Sierra Leone that cares for children in the most vulnerable time of their lives. Recently TRS took in a little girl who had been in an accident and lost her foot. She is doing well and is still in need of a \$45/month sponsorship.

Trinity is beginning to discuss sending a Missions Team to Sierra Leone again, likely in summer of 2025. If you would like more information about what that trip entails or to join the team, reach out to Pastor Matt, il mpearson@trinitylife.org.

Pastor Pimpinan reports on our second Global Mission Parther, the <u>NORTH SUMATRA</u> <u>INDONESIA CHURCH PLANT</u>. "Currently, we have four full-timers in our church specializing in different areas such as worship service, discipleship, social media, youth services, and evangelism. These individuals brought their unique talents and passions to the table, ensuring our church community thrived in every aspect. Together, this dedicated team worked harmoniously to nurture and expand our church family, making it a beacon of hope and love in our community. We are preparing to launch the third English Club session next month."

Exciting things are happening with <u>LITTLE MIRACLES</u>!! We recently expanded our services to serve families in need from 20 weeks of pregnancy through their child's second year! This change has been so beneficial, and we have had many families share with us how it has blessed them. Trinity's ministry is impacting families throughout the Omaha Metro area in meaningful ways. In July, we helped 24 children, which is the most we have supported in a single month so far. You may be asking yourself what this actually means. It means that we gave out over 2,400 diapers, 4,800 wipes, 112 containers of baby food, 40 toddler plates and bowls, 28 spoons and forks, 12 canisters of formula, 14 clothing gift certificates, 14 blankets, 98 bags of toddler snacks, 8 bibles, 8 devotionals, 3 cribs and



mattresses, 4 pack-n-plays, 4 high chairs, and much more. It also means that we were able to ask 24 families how we can be praying for them and walking alongside them. Little Miracles is doing big things through the generosity of Trinity Church.
