FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

Are you waiting on something? Wondering why God isn't answering your prayers? Does God even care? Advent is a season of waiting. It reminds us of the experiences of God's people. They had been waiting for thousands of years for the Christ, the Messiah to come and deliver his people and to destroy evil. Yet, God waited and so did the people.

Then after 400 years of what felt like complete silence - from the end of the Old Testament prophetic books until an Angel appeared to Zechariah and to Mary as told in the book of Matthew - the long awaited one comes to us in the flesh (incarnate), in a manger, in a tiny backwoods town.

Advent is a good reminder for all of us, as we wait (often impatiently) for God to respond and move, that God does hear us and does respond even if it's not in our timing or in our desired way.

This Advent and Christmas season our Sermon theme is "His Gospel is Peace". Join us in worship as we discover how Jesus takes away our fear. My hope is that this Christmas and Advent season draw you closer to Christ and that you fully experience the Gospel which brings peace!

I'm looking forward to seeing you all during Advent and at our Christmas services.

BAPTISM SUNDAY Sunday, January 12th, 2025

We have opportunity to celebrate what God is doing in the lives of those who have not yet been baptized. At Trinity, we lean into Jesus' command to be baptized. Within that command we realize disagreements around how and when are often over prioritized.

In obedience to Jesus' command, we baptize at any age (infant to 100+) and with any amount of water (sprinkle, drop, immersion). While it may be unknown how God works in the midst of both sacraments (communion and baptism), we simply trust and believe "for the forgiveness of sins" (communion) and through the water and the word (baptism) that God gives us the Holy Spirit and new life.

The invitation is open. If you have not yet been baptized and have put your faith and trust in Jesus, this is an opportunity to respond to His command to be baptized.
