

## **Note from Pastor Erik, Lead Pastor**

As I write this, the sounds, the sights, the lights, and the songs of Christmas are all around. A community event in our Commons is filled with Christmas trees and people preparing to celebrate the Christmas season. Driving through Papillion, we see the Winter Wonderland taking shape. Retail stores are preparing. The culture around us is preparing. The Church is preparing. In fits and starts this season of joy and expectation begins!

However, I draw a distinction between celebrating the Christmas season and celebrating Christmas.

Christmas is about the birth of our Savior. At Trinity, we focus on the Incarnation, God becoming a human being in the person of Jesus Christ. It is a wonder to me that God, who created it all, continues to bless all of creation with His presence. He became a human being to walk with us for a time.

Through the birth of Jesus, we realize that God understands our reality. He knows pain, the sting of death, deep sadness, and exuberant joy. He knows what we go through. And, most importantly, He cares deeply for each one of us.

The four Sundays that precede December 25th are called Advent. This word means coming. This season of preparation and introspection focuses our hearts on the precious gift of the Christ Child. It is also time to look to the future, for the scriptural promise that remains true: Jesus will come again.

Come explore with me our 2023 Advent theme "Wonder". We will consider the story of Christ's birth through four songs of scripture.

- December 3 Song of Mary Luke 1:46-55
- December 10 Song of Zechariah Luke 1:68-79
- December 17 Song of the Angels Luke 2:10-14
- December 24 Song of Simeon Luke 2:29-32

I encourage you to read these songs in preparation for worship each week asking yourself three important questions:

- 1. What does this ancient song sing into the challenges of our world today?
- 2. What does this song sing into the challenges of my own heart today?
- 3. What is the message of this song that I can carry into the future?

The celebration of the Christmas Season is a wonderful experience. Far more wonderful is the celebration of God, who became a human being to save us from our sins.

Throughout this newsletter are activities and experiences hosted by your Church family to build community and help us experience the Wonder of a God who sings into our lives His message of hope each day.

I look forward to celebrating the season and the Incarnation with you.


