
FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

We have been reading through the Bible as a congregation as we sit in our 2025 theme Alive and Active found in Hebrews 4:12.

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Most recently we went through a section of scripture that I absolutely love. In first and second Samuel as well as first and second Kings, we walk into the history of God's people and Israel's kings. In these pages we see God anoint Saul then by David, the triumphs and failures, along with the kings that follow. These stories express the heights of joy and grace as well as the deep depravity of mankind.

Recently, Amazon Prime released a series entitled "House of David" that does a good job of walking through David's younger years before he was king, intertwined with the story of Coliath, Saul, and Samuel. This series is put together well and the acting is excellent. If the series and this section of scripture is of interest to you, I'd also recommend a book series called "Lion of War". 
