From the Pastor's Desk...

Hope. The promise for the future. Absent hope, darkness turns into despair. Absent hope, tomorrow is a painful repetition of today. Absent hope, brokenness turns into fear and disbelief.

Believers in Jesus are anchored in a true message of hope, rooted and confident in the promises of God. In Romans 8:24-25, Paul writes, "For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience." Our hope is not wishful thinking or unchecked optimism, but rather it is founded on the unchanging character and faithfulness of God. Our hope is an essential characteristic of our faith in Jesus Christ.

This hope bursts into our lives through Christ's death and resurrection. As Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 15:19-20, "If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep."

God raised Jesus from the dead to bring hope and new life to you. The depth of the hole you are in, the darkness surrounding your life, the fears, the disappointments, the frustrations, they cannot stand up to this hope and new life in Jesus Christ.

While Lent takes us on a journey of Jesus' deep suffering and death. Easter launches us into the heights of joy and hope. The best way to experience Easter is through Lenten preparation. Ash Wednesday was just a few days ago. During that service, the message called us to the gift of fasting which creates a vacant space to fill with the living presence of Jesus. Each week of Lent, we are walking a journey of how God has provided for us to fill that emptiness. On March 5, Vision Sunday and the weeks that follow offer concrete ways to fill the empty places and deepen our hunger for the hope God gives us. This is my invitation to you to join me on Sundays and Wednesday as we grow together.

Friends, as we journey through Lent and into Easter, my prayer is that we each live into the hope of Christ and experience new ways to fill the vacant spaces in our hearts with the living presence of Jesus Christ.


