From the Pastor's Desk...

I want to say thank you for your graciousness. The last months have been a personal challenge for me, and the next months will present new challenges as I heal. I appreciate your support and understanding. It is a blessing to lead this congregation and to be surrounded by your kindness and prayers.

Trinity is truly blessed by the ministry we continue to build together. On March 2nd we enter the season of Lent. It is 40 days beginning on Ash Wednesday and concluding on Holy Saturday (the day before Easter). Remember, Lent does not include Sundays because they are ALWAYS a celebration of the resurrection.

Lent is a meaningful opportunity to focus on deepening our relationship with Jesus Christ. It is a season of faith building. It is a time to wrestle with some of the challenging questions of life, while we allow God to shape us into the disciples we are created to be. I want to encourage you to join in the upcoming church-wide Forgiving Challenge.

With our focus on Forgiveness, Sundays will be built around the acronym S.C.A.R.S. - Sin, Confession, Absolution, Restoration, and Sanctification. I know that is a bunch of big church words. We will break them down for deeper understanding. Each week during worship we will participate in the Lord's Supper and offer a time of prayer. I look forward to worshipping with each of you.

Wednesday evenings in Lent, we will dig deeper still, exploring how this process of forgiveness can bless our lives, as well as the lives of those around us. And, as always, we will enjoy soup, desserts, and fellowship together before worship.

If you have not purchased the book we will be using, "Forgiving Challenge" by Zach Zehnder, I encourage you to do so. This will allow you to go deeper, wrestle with some of those challenging questions around living free, opening the door for a fuller understanding of forgiveness, both for yourself and others.

My prayer is that this season of Lent is one in which we each grow closer to Jesus, rest in His assurance of forgiveness, and learn to intentionally share His love in the world.

What a beautiful month February was! Didn't ever expect 50+ degree weather in February when a year ago we were sitting in -40 degree wind chills for several days. The joy of Nebraska weather is that we get to enjoy every aspect of weather - from the joys of equatorial heat and humidity to the feel of frozen North Pole temps. I'll gladly take the 50's every day in February.

Last month we had some really cool things happen. A few guests from The Raining Season joined us in worship. TRS has been a Trinity Church mission partner for more than 10 years. Jason Rust and Lori Pyle shared with us the story of the work and ministry that is being done through TRS to rescue, empower, and restore orphans in Sierra Leone, West Africa. They brought good news that we were able to celebrate about Mary Kamara (Trinity Kids sponsored child). Although Mary has aged out of the orphanage, she now lives in the Roots Center and is the first TRS kid to be approved for the University. What an incredible achievement!!

Those present for worship and watching online were moved by the stories and testimony of ministry in Sierra Leone through TRS. Many responded by sponsoring children. God is at work through our partnership with this incredible organization. Our first LIFE YOUNIQUE course wrapped up in February. Each participant processed through their story, their gifting, and their passions all leading to discovery about God's unique and special calling for their lives. There were engaging conversations and experiences each week within the table groups. The course wrapped up with participants identifying a 90-day goal based on their calling. It felt good for me to be part of this opportunity to really connect people to each other, to help them understand that God made them uniquely, and to offer support as each person laid out an action plan to walk toward their goal and into things that matter. I look forward to having an opportunity walk with you the next time Life Younique is offered.

As we enter Lent in March, I pray this season is a time that you draw deeper into faith and are reminded each and every day that the grace of God is sufficient for you.

Greetings People of Trinity Church,

As I write this newsletter article in the middle of February, I see that tomorrow's outside temperature is supposed to get up to 62 degrees and the next day, 50. In the church, we celebrate Ash Wednesday as the beginning of the season of Lent. It is a season meant for self-reflection and faith practice that reminds us of our humanity and humility before God. Lent prepares us to more fully celebrate the joy of the Easter season when it comes.

The fact is that both the seasons of nature and the seasons of our lives are constantly in motion. One season leads into the next whether we are ready or not. Internship is a season of ministry for Matt in which he is invited to focus on learning and developing his practice of ministry. Within the internship year there are also seasons of ministry where some things come to the forefront and others wait their turn. This season, Matt has been hard at work developing and beginning to implement his internship project in the Yunique small group program. This month he will participate in leading Lenten worship and small group discussion using the Forgiveness Challenge materials. Exploring a new model for midweek Lenten worship is a way for Matt to explore what it means to be a worship leader as well as a leader who encourages others to grow. Please consider joining into the practice of Lent at Trinity, so that God can use this as a time for growth in your life as well as a season of growth and deepening faith in the community at Trinity.

No matter what season of life you are in, God's promise to you is that God's love is never-changing. The Holy Spirit comes to bring us what we need to thrive in each and every season of life. May we know the power of God's love to bless and equip us to live the gospel in all seasons.



Cooperation is the focus of our March lesson series, Jam Session.


All month we'll be looking at how


