This article is not about finances. It is about capitalizing on the life God is giving you. It might best be understood using the concept of finances, so hang in there and read on!

If afflicted with the propensity to watch financial news, your head might be swimming. Highly respected financial gurus find themselves at opposite ends of the spectrum and everywhere in between. Wisdom is properly shared about starting to save as early in life as possible. Then diversity in opinion enters through the discussion of where to save, what your portfolio mix should be, the proper use of debt, choices around housing, and best places to live.
