

A 21-Day Challenge to Walk with Jesus

Hi Families!

I'm excited to share something special happening in our student ministry! At the end of our Elevate Retreat, I challenged students to participate in a 21-Day challenge called Rhythms. For 21 days, they will follow a daily guide filled with intentional practices to help them grow in their faith. The rhythms include three times of kneeling prayer a day, reading one chapter of John (since there are 21 chapters), reflecting on Psalm 23 daily, walking outside for 21 minutes without technology, and limiting social media and video games to 90 minutes a week.

You might be thinking, "There's no way students will do all that!" But I'm thrilled to share that many of them are fully embracing the challenge together. Would you join me in praying for them as they begin these rhythms to deepen their relationship with Jesus?
