From the Pastor's Desk....

One modern worship song that has captured my heart and imagination is Way Maker by Nigerian gospel singer Sinach. The chorus repeats this phrase twice: "Way maker, miracle worker, promise keeper, light in the darkness, My God, that is who you are." Day after day at Trinity Church, we encounter the "Way Maker" lifting lives that are low and healing the broken.

Our God continues to make a way for us. God performs miracles around us all the time. His promises are real and true. When we walk through the darkness, our God shines the light of Jesus Christ into our lives giving us hope.

Way Maker - God has set a path in front of us. He has given us direction that we faithfully follow. That direction is the unique and specific mission: Connecting People to Christ. As we connect people to Christ, we are providing that awesome opportunity for God to form us, shape us, and grow us. Our vision as a congregation is to be a place to belong and become who God is calling us to be. Miracle Worker - I believe we look too often for those huge miracles, when God is working special miracles around us all the time. Lives are transformed. We are forgiven. All miracles!

Promise Keeper - One of the most meaningful and powerful realities of God revealed in the Bible is that our God keeps every promise. Let me just share a few. God promises to be with us: And I will be with you always, even to the end of the age. (Matthew 28:20) God promises us rest: Come to me all who labor and are heavy laden and I will give you rest. (Matthew 11:28) God promises forgiveness: If we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9) God's faithfulness: The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. (Hebrews 13:5)

Light in the darkness - Life is truly beautiful. Life also has its challenges. Our world is a mess right now. People are hurting. Some walk through the "valley of the shadow". Depression, anxiety, and PTSD are rampant. Relationships are struggling. Fear, uncertainty, concern, they are all driving people to their knees. Into every situation, our God shines the eternal light of hope. In John 1:5 NIV we read, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

That is who our God is: Way maker, miracle worker, promise keeper, light in the darkness. He is there for you. Take hold. Hang on. Be blessed.

A Message from Matt Pearson's Internship Supervisor

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! My name is Pastor Ellen Stelzle, and I currently serve at St. Thomas Lutheran Church in Omaha. My husband, Michael, and I have lived in Omaha for the last 17 years, and we have 2 grown children. For 5 years, I served as chair of the Nebraska Synod Candidacy Committee, which helps raise up new leaders for the church. Now I am blessed with the opportunity to serve as Matt Pearson's internship supervisor as he continues his journey towards becoming an ordained pastor. This means that in addition to the guidance Matt receives from his work supervisor, Pastor Erik, I will help guide Matt through his internship experience.

Internship is designed to be a yearlong process of learning and growth in all areas of ministry. It involves trying new things as well as digging deeper into the familiar, all while reflecting on how God is forming Matt for future ministry in the church. You will see Matt continue in many of the roles in which he currently serves. You will also see Matt doing new things, and familiar things in new ways. This is all part of exploring his call to ministry and developing his vision and voice as a leader.

As a teaching site, you, the people of Trinity, play a crucial role in Matt's internship experience. I know you already value him as an effective and beloved leader. That he is! It will be important to continue to support him in this next chapter of his formation through your participation in the life of the congregation and in your honest and faithful feedback. Internship is a time to be curious about what God is up to - how God is calling both Matt and the congregation to witness and minister in the world. It is a time to celebrate all of God's gifts for ministry. It is also the time for Matt to make his best mistakes so he can learn from them and grow into a more wise, seasoned, and gracious leader.

Matt will also be supported by an Internship Committee of people from Trinity, led by Jay Cruse, that will provide Matt additional feedback, support and perspective. The committee will be a trusted sounding board for Matt as he processes his learning and growth.

Internship is time for Matt to integrate what he is learning at seminary with the practice of ministry in the congregation. It is his time to learn by doing. I have already seen the Holy Spirit alive and active at Trinity, providing fertile ground for the seeds of Matt's leadership and pastoral identity to grow. I look forward to seeing you from time to time as we journey this path together. May God bless us along the way and lead us all to deeper faith and trust in Jesus, the risen Christ.
