Note from Pastor Erik, Lead Pastor

One of the most joyful places in Papillion is the Commons at Trinity between Sunday services. Some of the joy includes people enjoying donuts and drinking coffee around great conversation. Children everywhere including those who have been to Trinity Kids are happily showing off their crafts to parents and grandparents. We find seniors, teenagers, and infants, too. Biological families and "Church families". We are a mix of new Christians and lifetime Christians and everything in between. Our Commons is truly a special place.

This space reminds me of the words of Apostle John in 1 John 4:16: "God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him." Hospitality is a foundational expression of love, compassion, and inclusivity. It's a practice rooted in our Trinity discipleship value of Gather. When we extend hospitality, we are experiencing community, and reflecting the teachings of Jesus who welcomed all with open arms. Expressing hospitality creates an environment where everyone feels cared for, valued, and accepted.

I imagine not everyone thinks about offering hospitality to God by extending hospitality to others. But that is what you are doing when you share hospitality with others. You are an extension of Christ's hospitality to us.

There are many ways we extend hospitality at Trinity Church. We have greeters as people come into the Commons and worship spaces. There is also informal hospitality when we pull up another chair to the table to make room for someone or expanding a circle and inviting a new person into a group conversation. Buying a coffee for someone or helping a parent with their children are all forms of hospitality.

What touches my heart the most is when I see the Trinity family intentionally reaching out to guests or to people they don't know. Because the Spirit of Christ lives within all believers, when a guest is walked to our Next Steps area, a door opens for connection. We are living our mission through our hospitality.

Alexandre Dumas is given credit for the phrase, "nothing succeeds like success." The energy and joy in the Commons is clearly a success as each of us extends hospitality. What would it mean to reach out to that person you have seen at Trinity several times, but don't know by name? What would it take to walk with someone over the Next Steps area and start the process of connecting? What single step could you take to experience the success of your hospitality and ramp it up to a higher level of success?

There is a reward for hospitality. The writer of Hebrews expresses it this way, "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares." (Hebrews 13:2) We have some angels here. There are more to come. Let's extend hospitality, let success succeed, and see who God brings into our Church family.
