Thank you for the impact you are making!

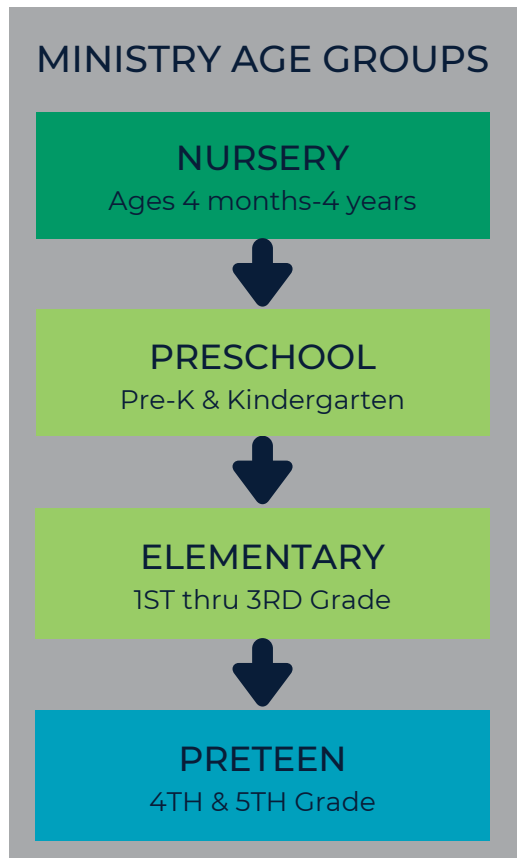
Kids' lives aren't changed because of cool music or amazing rooms or the latest technology. It is leaders, like YOU, that God uses to make an impact.

- Attend volunteer huddle 20 minutes before service.
- Assist with set up and tear down as needed.
- Provide a safe, fun and loving environment for kids and families.
- Invite others to serve along side you!
- Use the Services App for accepting and declining scheduled service times.
- Follow procedures to find a substitute when not able to serve.
- Attend all events, meetings, and gatherings for volunteers.
- Outside of Trinity Kids, make wise lifestyle and social media decisions, being kind in all you do.



CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

HOW TO ROCK CHECK-IN!

ARRIVE 20 MINUTES EARLY FOR VOLUNTEER HUDDLE

Wear Trinity Kids shirt

Be in place at check-in 10 min early



ENSURE CHECK-IN STATIONS ARE READY

Use your own check-in as a test print!



ASSIST REGULAR AND GUEST CHECK-INS WITH A SMILE!

See detailed procedures at the check-in desk.



GIVE FIRST TIME GUESTS THE VIP TREATMENT

Lanyards and bottles are kept at the Guest Check-In station.

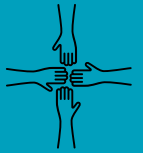

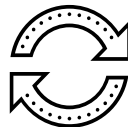

Welcome Team:

- Attend training for the check-in system and be familiar with troubleshooting issues.
- Greet families as they are entering.
- Ensure that each kid is efficiently checked in and receives a name badge, and parents receive claim tag.

Time Commitment:

- One service (either 9am or 10:30am) every other week.

Nursery Team:

- Love on babies and toddlers in your care each week.
- Build a relationship with kids and families when possible.
- Pray with and for kids in your group.
- Review provided activities and stories prior to serving.

Time Commitment:

- One service (either 9am or 10:30am) every other week.

Trinity Kids Volunteer Profiles

Kids Team:

Our Worship Leaders, Storytellers and Large Group Leaders create an atmosphere that gives kids an opportunity to learn about and connect with Jesus.

- Lead with lots of energy, engagement and control.
- Build relationships with kids in the group.
- Prepare ahead of serving by reviewing lesson materials.
- Pray for and with kids in the group.

Time Commitment:

- One service (either 9am or 10:30am) every other week.
- 20 minutes during the week to review the lesson and activities and be prepared to lead .

Small Group Leader:

Without a relationship, it's impossible to influence a kid's faith in a significant way. By serving every week, you become someone they trust and want to follow.

- Build a relationship with kids in your group, so every kid is known, cared for, and valued.
- When possible, connect with parents to build a relationship with the whole family.
- Prepare ahead of serving by reviewing lesson materials.
- Pray for and with kids in your group.

Time Commitment:

- One service EVERY WEEK (9 or 10:30am).
- 20 minutes during the week to review the lesson and activities and be prepared to lead.

Scheduling

Step 1: Know which Sundays you serve each month. It will be the same every month unless you need to change with someone (see Step 2). This will be a great opportunity to build a friendship with your teammates that serve with you!

Step 2: Scheduling conflict. Reach out to someone directly or in the Facebook group and ask them to switch with you. Please let us know about the switch so we can update the Services App to correctly reflect the scheduling. Go to the Services App for all volunteer contact information.

Step 3: Scheduling conflict with no one able to switch. Reach out to a substitute volunteer from the list provided. If no one is available, see Step 4.

Step 4: Last resort: Ask TK Staff to fill in for you. We don't mind filling in occasionally, but have realized that the best place for us to be on a Sunday is...everywhere! Ideally, we would be able to greet first-time guest families and show them around, connect with parents and kids as they walk in, or be able to troubleshoot last-minute issues.



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
